The Annapurna Base Camp trek is one of the most popular treks in Nepal because it offers so much more than just views of the world's tallest peaks—you also get to see villages that have been passed down from generation to generation. And if you're lucky, there might even be some yak roaming around!

There are plenty of opportunities for adventure along the way. From horseback riding through rivers and streams to hiking through jungle-like terrain, there's more than enough excitement to keep you on your toes.



It's a challenge that's worth it:

Trekking the Annapurna Base Camp is no walk in the park. The trek starts at 3,440 meters (11,280 feet) above sea level and climbs to over 4,300 meters (14,000 feet), which means you'll be going through some serious altitude sickness. But that doesn't mean it's not worth it! When you get to the top and see the Himalayas for the first time, you'll be glad you worked for it.
