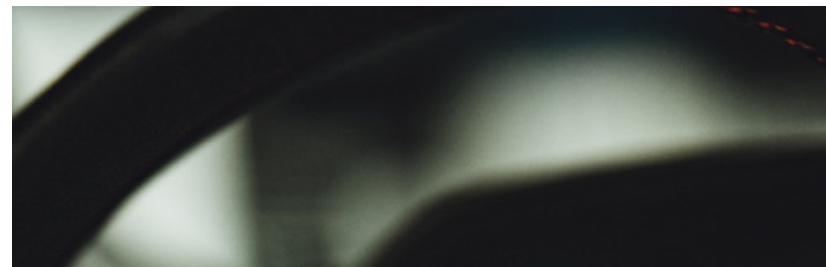
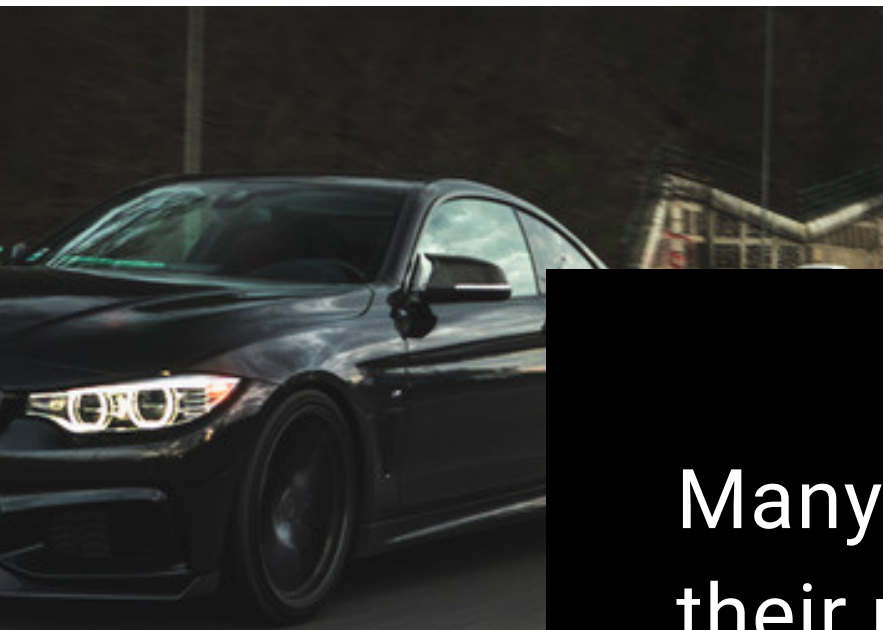
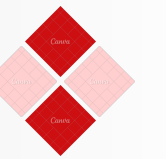
WHAT IS ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE?

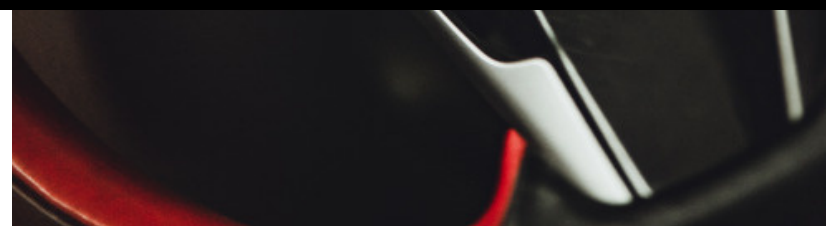




JOIN AN AUTO CLUB

Confirm with your vehicle insurance provider to see if they offer roadside assistance as supplementary to your policy. Bundling services can be more cost-effective than purchasing them separately, and you may even qualify for a discount.



COMPARE SERVICE PLANS

OPT FOR PAY-PER-USE PLANS
