


How soon you will experience the therapeutic benefits of your medication is likely to be one of your top concerns if you have a condition that is being treated with medical cannabis.

The way in which you are taking your cannabis prescription is by far the most important of the many factors that can affect the answer to this question. There are two main methods for consuming medical cannabis, each of which works differently and has a distinct duration:







Cannabis flower:

Most patients consume their medicinal cannabis as "flower," which is subsequently vaporized. This is the quickest acting and shortest lasting way to consume medical cannabis; the effects peak in 10 minutes and last for one to three hours on average.

Because of this, individuals who use medicinal cannabis to address emergencies like acute anxiety or panic attacks may discover that this quick-acting way of taking their prescription is most effective for them.



Cannabis oil:

Taking cannabis oil sublingually, which entails putting drops under the tongue, is another technique to use medical cannabis.

The benefits of cannabis oil normally peak after two hours, but they can potentially linger much longer—sometimes up to 24 hours—because it works more slowly than vaporized flower.

For example, if you take a dose of cannabis oil a few hours before bed, you are less likely to have trouble falling asleep and remaining asleep during the night. This indicates that cannabis oil can be more effective at treating chronic pain disorders, general anxiety, or difficulty sleeping.

Similarly, if a person experiences daytime anxiety, taking their first dose of cannabis oil right after waking up may help to reduce that anxiety throughout the day.



How long does marijuana last in my body?

This is determined by how frequently and how long you have used medical cannabis. For up to two to three days after a dose, very infrequent users can be identified by a urine test, but individuals who use cannabis more frequently and consistently, like medical card holders, may discover that it remains detectable in their system for up to a month after their previous dose.
