



# Do You Need A Langtang Valley Trekking?



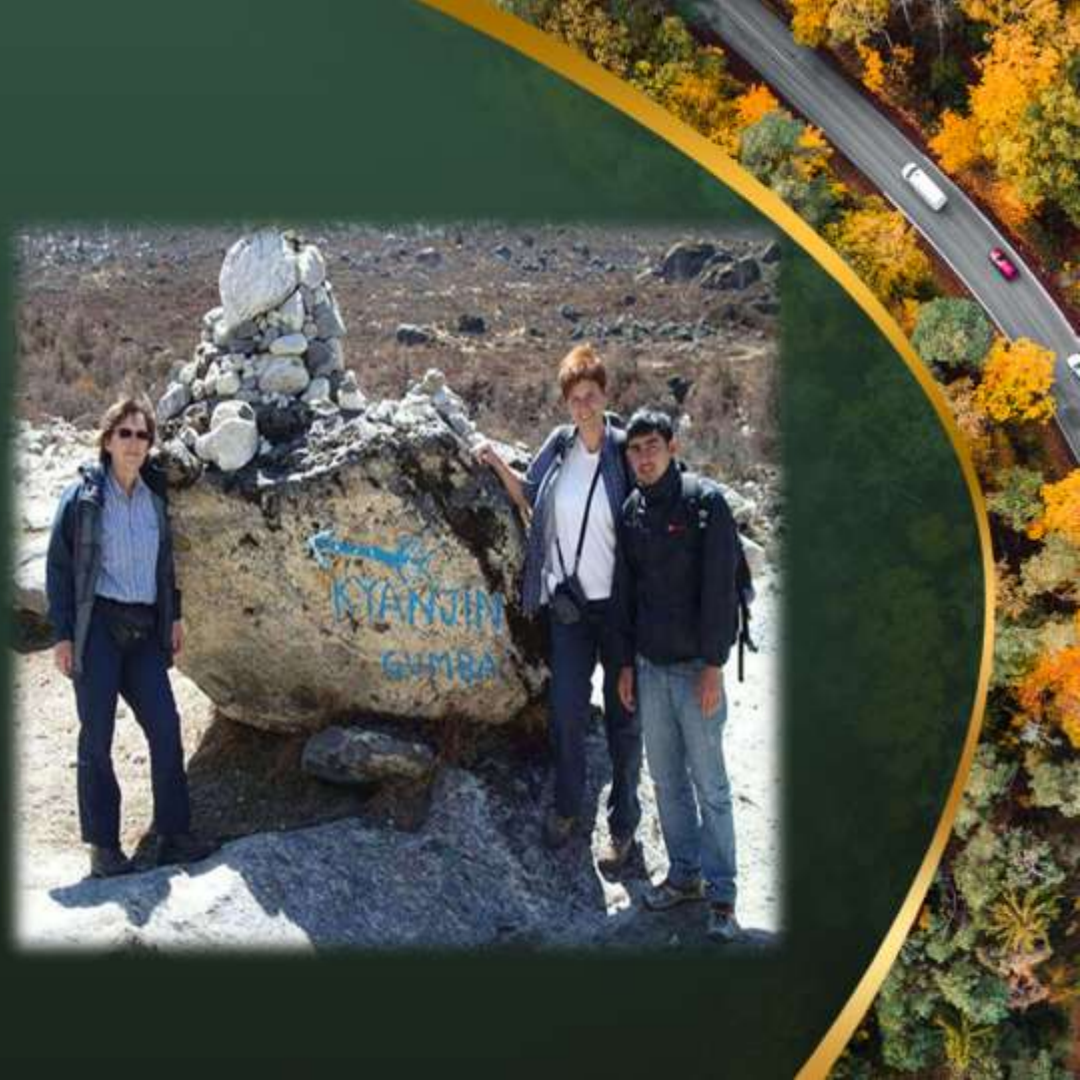
