Trekking Packages and Guides

A guided package generally covers almost all factors such as permits, feeding, shelter, and a guide. Usually, a guided trek would cost ₹3000- ₹ 5000 depending on the length of the trek. Lounging around waiting is less expensive, however, acquiring finding permits, transportation and securing lodgings is up to you.



Permits and Entry Fees

Two major permits will be required for this trek: the Sagarmatha National Park permit plus the TIMS (Trekkers' Information Management System) card. These cost around ₹1500- ₹2000 combined. Though it does not contribute a great deal in percentage to the Everest base camp trek price, it is an important item to consider in the budget.

Accommodation and Food Costs



It might be impossible to trek up to Everest Base Camp, not to mention sleeping in Locales on the way to the base camp. Accommodation is fairly cheap ranging from per night, that's if you can get a room. However, food might be more expensive than you think. For example, the cost of a simple but complete vegetarian fare such as Dal Bhat might be ₹1000-₹1200 at lower elevations but can easily increase about twofold as you ascend. On average, one may incur approximately ₹700-₹1000 on food every day.

Modes of Transportation for the Trek

Most of the trekkers head to Kathmandu first and then take a flight to Lukla. This is how the majority of the trekkers will start their trip. The cost of a round-trip flight ranges anywhere from ₹500-₹800, this also is dependent on the season. However, if you are travelling on a budget, it is possible to bus to Jiri and then hike an extra week to reach Lukla, although it will lengthen the overall time for your journey.

• Equipment and Accessories

The cost of the Everest base camp trek offer also comprises expenditures on equipment such as trekking shoes, warm coats, sleeping bags, bed rolls and others. If you do not have these things, they can be purchased or hired in Kathmandu.
